Clerking/assistance: if you are able to clerk or help in any way please contact the show manager ASAP. Clerks will be paid £25 per day. Stewards will be paid £10 per day. Everyone involved will receive lunch.

**KITTENS** – Any kitten entered must be at least 4 calendar months but less than 8 calendar months on the date of show. Neutered kittens may be entered. **HOUSEHOLD PETS**– HHP's over 8 months of age must be neutered or spayed.

EACH BEST IN SHOW CATEGORY WINNERS WILL ALSO BE AUTOMATICALLY ENTERED INTO OVERALL BEST IN SHOW, TO BE ASSESSED BY OUR JUDGE, THE WINNER WILL BE AWARDED THE MARLEY'S SONG MEMORIAL TROPHY, OVERALL BIS ROSETTE, BAG OF FOOD AND OTHER GOODIES

**JUDGING:** starts promptly at 4pm on Friday and 9.30am on Saturday and Sunday.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS** – this is a **fully vetted** show. Up to date vaccination cards must be produced at check in. The Vet's decision to refuse entry is final.

**Vetting in** – Friday from 3pm-4pm, Saturday from 8am to 9:30am, Sunday 8.30am to 9am

The Show Manager reserves the right to remove any cat showing any signs of illness, mites, fleas, fungal infections etc. in accordance with TICA rules. Cats from household where there has been an infectious disease/fungal infection within 21 days of the first day of the show are ineligible for entry. Any cat obviously pregnant or lactating will be disqualified. All claws's, front & back, must be clipped prior to judging.

**CHECK IN**: Exhibitors must check in on each day of attendance in order for an absentee list to be compiled for the judges. Cats may not leave the show hall prior to the advertised hours without the Show Manager's consent.

Confirmations – Please enclose an SAE if an e-mail address has not been supplied. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the confirmation slips issued – please check carefully. If you do not receive a confirmation email before the closing date for entries, please contact the entry clerk. This is a 18 Ring Show and the entry fee will include a £1 donation to the EW Regional Fund.

**PEN HIRE**: There is a limited supply of 48" metal pens on a "first come, first served" basis, which must be hired in advance via payment page, at £10 each for the duration of the show.

**CATERING** – there is catering in the Leisure Centre or from the Town Centre outside of the venue.



**BENCHING** —. Double SPACES (4ft x 2ft x 2ft) will be supplied by the club. Exhibitors must supply their own litter trays, litter, cat food & water. Litter bins will be provided but **exhibitors are requested to bag their rubbish before placing in the bins**.

## TRANSPORT & DIRECTIONS

**By Air:** Airports in commuting distance are Bristol, Cardiff, Birmingham and Heathrow. The nearest airport operating the PETS system is Bristol.

**REGISTRATION** – with the exception of New Breeds & New Traits, registration with TICA is not required to compete in a cat's first show. However, registration is required for confirmation of titles and scoring for TICA Regional & International awards.
